Beer price will be 35¢ per bottle; name brands of rye, gin and vodka with set-ups - \$12 per bottle; Scotch and bourbon - \$14 per bottle. Beer per case - \$8. The new fee for each adult is \$4.50 which includes buffet, orchestra, Mass, soda, tax and gratuity.

Buffet will be served starting at 5 p.m. Music 7 - 10. Nearest head count was 65 adults, 11 (12-17 yrs.) 20 (under 12 yrs.)
