2004 WINKLER REUNION

The Hubert and Anna Winkler family has been celebrating its existence with family reunions for approximately 50 years. These reunions were usually scheduled every other year but have occasionally varied from that frequency. Over this long period of time the reunions have been held in the winter as well as the summer and have included a dinner atmosphere as well as a picnic atmosphere.

Each reunion has been organized and undertaken by a small group of volunteers from the family. The goal of this "committee" has always been to provide a reunion that would be appealing to all at a reasonable cost. Over time, many things have changed, especially the costs. Each reunion committee has been faced with tough choices regarding what to include in the face of rising costs.

At the last reunion (2002) the committee decided to put a questionnaire into the program to solicit opinions from attendees of the reunion. The idea of the questionnaire was to provide an opportunity to get responses that could be used for planning the next reunion. That worked reasonably well and a questionnaire will be included again this year. The questionnaire responses, and well as some verbal responses, generally focused on two principal areas: Developing a more equitable distribution of the costs taking into account the kids, and establishing a price structure that would not require some people to pay for beverages that they would not consume (i.e. beer and soda).

To that end, this year's committee has established a graduating cost based on age and decided to remove the beer and soda costs from the overall costs. So, this year, the beer and soda (and mixed drinks) will be available on a pay as you go basis at the inside bar and beer and soda will be available at the outside pavilion. Both of these actions should provide a more equitable distribution of the costs.

In spite of this effort, the costs are higher than what we all expected. In reviewing this, we were again reminded that the individual charge for the reunion includes costs for the mass, pavilion rental, insurance for the pavilion, the entertainment, the food, the bartenders, etc.. Additionally, many of these costs have gone up since our last reunion. The committee would like you to know the cost is as low as they could possibly make it and it only includes those things that the committee felt were absolutely necessary. They also hope everyone enjoys themselves at this year's reunion.

I want to personally thank all the members of this year's reunion committee for all the time and effort that they have willingly provided.
